# Get to know Malaysia better

> Host Ezra Zaid shows us 10 things we may not be aware about our country

**IF** you think you know everything there is to know about Malaysia, then think again.

Did you know that the KTM building was actually built to withstand snow? Or that Malaysia is home to the biggest cockroach infestation in the world? And Mt Kinabalu is home to the highest suspension bridge in the world?

Well, you can join host Ezra Zaid who will take you on a journey around the country to discover some interesting aspects that you may or may not know on History channel's *10 Things You Don't Know About Malaysia* this Malaysia Day. Ezra was previously best known for hosting *That Effing Show* on YouTube and as a presenter on BFM 89.9.

During an interview session with the people behind this documentary, we found out why this programme needed to be made and why it meshes with the History channel's own theme.

Chris Humphrey, the director-producer at A+E Networks Asia (the people behind History), explained: "We have done it with the US and revolved it around people like Franklin Delano Roosevelt (the 32nd president of the United States), for example: 10 things you did not know about him."

He said that both Asian and US markets are different, and it was easier to do this type of series around Malaysia rather than focus on one specific person.

"We have a big audience here and we have doubled the time.

Shows like this is usually half-an-hour long but this is a one-hour show."

Harun Rahman, who is the director, producer and editor at Novista Sdn Bhd (the company that produced this documentary), said that they spent six months doing research before shooting began for the documentary.

"There were many things we found that most people didn't know about Malaysia. Then we had to decide which was visually interesting and sell it to the broadcaster."

Harun added that they had to also verify the authenticity of every detail and fact they unearthed.

Ezra said Malaysians have great stories to tell, adding that this show is for Malaysians. He said: "We don't know enough about our own backyard. I think viewers will be surprised by the [things we discovered] about the KL railway station."

"This is just one of the many aspects of our history, architecture and natural history that we are not paying enough attention to.

"By putting a spotlight on it, it gives us a peek into our history as well as about those involved in the making of our country."

Harun added that he hopes people will look at Malaysia differently once they watch this documentary.

"Malaysians don't seem to care much about history. They forget and don't learn from it."

"I hope people will have a clear and more in-depth view of things after watching this show."

Humphrey added his own hopes that the audience will realise that history can be entertaining too.

As for Ezra, he said he wants people to look at our history and say Malaysia is pretty cool.

"There is no need to add any more to it or try to gloss over things to make a pretty package. Sometimes, the warts and dirty bits are equally a part of our history as well."


